Sub: Conduct of Competitive Written Examination for the posts of Junior Stenographer against CSIR-4PI Advt. No.02/2025 – reg.

Ref: Stenography shorthand result notified vide CSIR-4PI notification no.4PI/02(2)/2025 dated 14.05.2026.

In continuation of the CSIR-4PI notification cited above, it is hereby notified for the information of candidates who have qualified in the Proficiency Test in Stenography that they are eligible to appear for the next stage of the recruitment process, i.e., the Competitive Written Examination for the post of Junior Stenographer (JST). The exam is scheduled to be held on 21.06.2026 (Sunday) at CSIR-4PI, Bengaluru.

The details of the written examination for JST are as follows:

The Scheme of the Written Examination as provided in [Advt. No. 02/2025](#) remains the same.

Instructions:

1. The admit card will be sent through email to all the eligible candidates.
2. Candidates are required to take a printout of the admit card, duly fill in the candidate's details and affix a recent self-attested passport-size photograph. The same is required to be submitted at the time of written examination, i.e., at the reporting time indicated above.
3. Candidates are required to carry two passport size photo along with them.
4. The candidates are required to produce their Original Admit Card along with Aadhar Card as proof of identity.
5. No candidate shall be permitted to enter the Examination Hall without a valid Admit Card and original Photo Identity Proof (Aadhaar Card).
6. If there is any mismatch between the name indicated in the Admit Card and the Aadhar Card, the candidate will not be allowed to appear for the Written Examination.

7. Any request for change of Date / Time / Venue of the Written Examination shall NOT be entertained under any circumstances.
8. Candidates must abide by further instructions, if any, issued by the Invigilator at the time of the Written Examination. If any candidate fails to abide by the instructions or indulges in disorderly or improper conduct, they will render themselves liable for expulsion from Written Examination or such other penalty as the Competent Authority, CSIR-4PI may deem fit.
9. Only Blue or Black Ball Point Pen for marking responses on the OMR Answer Sheet is allowed.
10. Candidates may note that there will be 0.25 negative marks for every wrong answer in the OMR-based Objective Type Multiple Choice Examination.
11. Candidates are required to maintain discipline and decorum for smooth conduct of the Written Examination.
12. On completion of the Written Examination, the candidates shall remain seated and wait until the OMR Sheets and Admit Cards are collected and accounted for.
13. Candidates shall ensure that they return the OMR Sheets and Admit Cards to the Invigilator before leaving the venue. Candidates failing to return the same shall be disqualified and may be liable for suitable action as per rules.
14. No TA/DA shall be paid for attending the Written Examination.
15. Candidates are not allowed to bring any type of electronic gadgets such as Mobile Phones, Calculators, Tabs, Laptops, Bluetooth Devices, Smart Watches, etc., into the Written Examination Hall except Admit Card and Aadhar Card.
16. The candidature for this Written Examination is provisional and subject to fulfilling the prescribed criteria relating to age, educational qualifications and other conditions specified in the advertisement. This admit card is issued purely based on the details furnished by the candidate in the online application form, which is subject to detailed scrutiny. If at any stage of recruitment any discrepancy is found or the candidate does not fulfil the eligibility criteria, the candidature is liable to be cancelled.
17. Any point not specifically covered in the above instructions, the decision of the Competent Authority, CSIR-4PI, Bengaluru shall be final and binding on all candidates.
18. Candidates are requested to visit the CSIR-4PI website regularly for recruitment updates.
